Today we emphasized that Noah's actions pleased God. Because Noah pleased God, God asked him to build a boat, and Noah obeyed. Do you let your child know when his actions please you? It is important to set boundaries for your child and say no, but your child needs to know when you are pleased with what he does. Look for opportunities this week to say to your child, “Thank you for obeying (sharing, being kind). You make God so happy when you obey. And you make me happy too!”
