

2s and 3s Lesson Truths Fall Quarter 2007

Weeks 1–5: Obedience

Based on stories from the life of Noah, your child will learn what obedience is and that obedience to God, parents, and teachers pleases God. Noah's life pleased God, and Noah obeyed God in all aspects of constructing the boat and putting the animals and food on board.

Weeks 6–10: God's Gifts

Based on the experiences of God's people, the Israelites, your child will learn how God gave His people meat, bread, water, and clothes. Your child will realize God cares for him and meets his needs too. Each week we want your child to thank God for one specific provision: meat, bread, water, clothes.

Weeks 11–13: Thanksgiving

Learning how the Israelites celebrated the Feast of the Tabernacles will help your child focus on the thanksgiving theme. He will learn the importance of thanking God for all that He has given him.

Noah Obeys God

Genesis 6:5–13

One day God looked at the people on earth and became very sad. He was sad because the people were doing bad things.

But God found one man who made Him happy. That man was Noah. Noah made God happy because he obeyed God. Other people did not obey. This made God sad.

God told Noah it was going to rain for many days. The earth would have water all over it. God wanted Noah and his family to be safe. So God told Noah to build a very BIG boat. It took Noah and his family a very, VERY, VERY long time to build this boat. Noah cut big pieces of wood. He pounded many nails into boards.

Noah made God happy when he obeyed. You make God happy when you obey.

Let's talk about the picture:

1. Point to Noah. Why did he make God happy?
2. Point to the big boat. Why did Noah have to build a boat?
3. Point to Noah's sons. What are they doing?

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Note to Parents

If you keep each picture card your child brings home, you will soon have quite a collection of Bible stories and pictures. We suggest that you punch a hole in the upper left corner of each card.
