<b>Fall 2007</b> <i>Kindness</i> <i>Helpfulness</i> <i>Prayer</i>  (Packet #1234)	Kindness (stories about David); Helpfulness (stories about Elisha); Prayer	Genesis; 1, 2 Samuel; 2 Kings; Nehemiah; Psalms; Proverbs; Matthew; Luke; Galatians; Ephesians	Pre-primary children will learn about Bible people who were kind and helpful and who prayed. They will have opportunities to practice kindness and helpfulness and will be encouraged to talk to God in prayer.
<b>Winter 2007—08</b> <i>God's Promised Son</i>  (Packet #1235)	Jesus' Birth; Jesus' Boyhood (wise men; Egypt; in the temple at age 12); Jesus' Life (various miracles)	Jeremiah; Matthew—Acts; 1 John	These three units will help children know that Jesus is God's Son, that Jesus grew and became a man, that Jesus can do miracles, and that Jesus loves us. Pre-primaries will enjoy doing Christmas activities because they will be celebrating Jesus' birth.
<b>Spring 2008</b> <i>Jesus</i> <i>Salvation</i> <i>Church</i> (Packet #1236)	Jesus (Easter); Salvation; Church (the first church; prayer; deacons; missionaries)	Psalms; Jeremiah; Matthew; John—1 Corinthians; James; 1 John	Pre-primary children will learn that Jesus is our Savior and that church is an important part of God's plan. They will be able to identify what sin is, why we need a Savior, and why church is important.
<b>Summer 2008</b> <i>Joseph</i> <i>David</i> <i>Jonah</i> (Packet #1237)	Joseph (from new coat to prince of Egypt); David (from shepherd boy to king); Jonah	Genesis; 1, 2 Samuel; 1 Chronicles; Psalms; Jonah	Learning about Joseph, David, and Jonah will help pre-primary children know how to obey God. They will be encouraged to show love for God by obeying.
<b>Fall 2008</b> <i>Living for God</i>  (Packet #1238)	Love and Kindness (Rebekah, Isaac, Ruth, Abraham); Bravery (Daniel); Giving (to the church and to the poor)	Genesis; Exodus; Ruth; 2 Samuel; 1 Kings; Psalms; Proverbs; Daniel; Mark; Luke; 2 Corinthians; Hebrews; 3 John	Children will learn about Bible characters who were loving, kind, brave, and giving. They will have opportunities to practice being kind and be encouraged to ask God for His help to be brave and live for Him.
<b>Winter 2008—09</b> <i>Jesus</i> <i>Esther</i> (Packet #1239)	Jesus, God's Son (His birth, baptism, various miracles); Esther (from becoming queen to saving her people)	Esther; Psalms; Matthew—John, Philippians; Hebrews	Pre-primary children will know that Jesus is God's Son and that Esther was obedient and helpful. They will be encouraged to show love for God by obeying and helping.
<b>Spring 2009</b> <i>God's World</i> <i>Jesus' Love</i> <i>Jesus' Friends</i>  (Packet #1240)	Creation; Jesus' Love (Easter); Jesus' Friends (Peter, John, Philip, Dorcas)	Genesis; Psalms; Isaiah; Matthew; Luke—1 Corinthians; 1 Peter; Revelation	These three units will help pre-primary children know what God made on each day of creation, that Jesus loves us and died for us, and that Jesus had friends. The children will thank God for His care, accept Him as Savior (if ready), and name ways they can love and serve Jesus.
<b>Summer 2009</b> <i>God's Helpers</i>  (Packet #1241)	Family (mothers, fathers, sisters, aunts, grandparents); Obedience (Samuel, David, servants); God's Helpers (Aquila, Priscilla, Barnabas, Luke, Onesimus)	1 Samuel; 2 Kings; Mark; John; Acts; Galatians; Ephesians; Colossians; Philemon; Hebrews; 1 John; 3 John	Pre-primary children will learn that God has given us our families. They will have opportunities to show love to family members and friends and will be encouraged to thank God for family and friends.
